## **2011 Great Women of Gaming 2012 Nomination Guidelines**

To nominate an individual as a 2011 Great Woman of Gaming, you must have worked with her within the gaming industry as a client, vendor or colleague in a corporate, trade association or industry event setting, and she must meet all qualifications of either the Proven Leader or Rising Star category.

### **Proven Leaders**

- Candidate has worked in the gaming industry for a minimum of 10 years and has been in her current position for at least 1 year by the April 23 nomination deadline.
- Candidate currently works for a company in the gaming industry and holds a management position.
- Candidate demonstrates exceptional achievement in at least 3 of the following areas:

1. Ability to go above and beyond job responsibilities
2. Commitment to company and co-workers
3. Contributions to the industry as a whole
4. Commitment to mentoring
5. Strong overall life balance

### **Rising Stars**

- Candidate has worked in the gaming industry for a minimum of 3 years and has been in her current position for at least 1 year by the April 23 nomination deadline.
- Candidate currently works for a company in the gaming industry and holds a management position.
- Candidate demonstrates exceptional commitment to at least 3 of the following areas:

1. Ability to go above and beyond job responsibilities
2. Commitment to company and co-workers
3. Contributions to the industry as a whole
4. Commitment to mentoring
5. Strong overall life balance

If your candidate meets these nomination criteria, submit the following materials to complete the nomination process.

### **Recommendation Letters and Nomination Form**

The Nomination Review Committee requires **at least 2 letters of recommendation**, with at least 1 from a direct supervisor. Please submit an electronic copy of all letters of recommendation to [events2@aceme.org](mailto:events2@aceme.org) and/or [editor2@aceme.org](mailto:editor2@aceme.org). Please include the nominee's name and "GWOG Recommendation" in the subject line.

Letters of recommendation should address each of the following 3 areas and include specific examples:

1. Of these categories, where does the nominee perform best?
  - Ability to go above and beyond job responsibilities
  - Commitment to company and co-workers
  - Contributions to the industry as a whole
  - Commitment to mentoring
  - Strong overall life balance
2. What is most notable about the nominee?
3. Why does the nominee deserve this award?

Please fill out the enclosed Nomination Form (next page down) in full and electronically submit it along with all other nomination materials.

### **Headshot, Biography and Additional Information**

A high-resolution (300 dpi or greater) color headshot of the nominee in .jpg, .tiff or .eps format is required. A 300-500 word biography in Word or PDF format of the nominee is also required.

You may send us any press releases, press clippings or additional information you feel may provide further insight into the nominee's qualifications for this award. Please do not submit more than six additional documents beyond the required materials. For example, you may send two extra letters of recommendation, two press releases, one photo and one article, or any combination thereof up to six. If seven or more are sent, we will ask you to choose which six are sent to our judges.

Overnight shipping is recommended if they are mailed. *By submitting your nomination for the 2011 Great Women of Gaming Awards, you and your company give CEM the right to republish any printed materials or images submitted in conjunction with this year's awards, including passages from letters of recommendation.*

### **Deadline for Nominations**

All nomination materials, including letters of recommendation, must be received by 5 p.m. CST on **Monday, April 23, 2012**. Late nominations will NOT be considered unless otherwise approved.
